Changing Take-out and Delivery Cutlery from Biomass Plastic to Wooden Materials [86 tons of plastic products reduction]

SKYLARK HOLDINGS CO., LTD. (Head Office: Musashino-shi, Tokyo; Chairman and CEO: Makoto Tani; TSE First Section: Stock Code: 3197, "Skylark" hereafter) is announcing that it has decided to sequentially replace biomass plastic with wooden cutlery (spoons, forks and knives) for take-out and delivery service at all restaurants of the Skylark Group from January 2022 and will continue to promote business activities to reduce its environmental impacts.
