Skylark to replace takeout and shopping bags from petroleum-based plastic to biomass plastic

Replacing plastic bags to biomass plastic bags (made from sugarcane)

to reduce environmental impact

From 2020 onwards, cutleries and takeaway containers to be sequentially switched

Skylark Holdings Co., Ltd. (headquartered in Musashino City, Tokyo; Chairman, President and CEO: Makoto Tani; code: 3197, Tokyo Stock Exchange; "Skylark," hereafter) has decided to replace takeout and shopping bags from disposable plastic to eco-friendly biomass plastic.

With the improper disposal of plastic waste becoming a serious environmental problem on a global scale, the Skylark group believes that efforts to reduce plastic waste are an important role as a restaurant chain operating all over Japan. The group began withdrawing disposable plastic drinking straws from December 2018 and completed the withdrawal in the end of July 2019 at all stores.

As a next step, the group is to replace takeout and shopping bags from petroleum-based to environmentally friendly biomass plastic bags. Biomass plastics are made from raw materials derived from plants (sugarcane pomace). By changing from petroleum-based plastic to 100% biomass plastic, CO₂ emissions can be reduced by approximately 180 tons / year, approximately 60%. Subsequently, takeout and delivery cutleries, and containers to be changed from plastic to eco-friendly products.
