Introduction of Off-site PPA Solar Power Service at Higashimatsuyama Merchandizing Center and 38 Stores in Kanto Area

~Accelerate Efforts to Achieve Virtually Zero CO₂ Emissions by 2050~

Skylark Holdings Co., Ltd. has introduced an off-site PPAs* utilizing solar power generation to Higashimatsuyama Merchandizing Center and 38 stores in Kanto Area from September 1.

This initiative is expected to enable the company to cover approximately 3,132 MWh of electricity annually with renewable energy and reduce CO₂ emissions by approximately 1,456 tons per year.

With the operation of this power plant, we have so far installed solar power generation systems at five merchandising centers and 1,178 stores.

*Off-site PPAs: A system to purchase renewable energy electricity on a long-term basis by installing equipment on “idle land” located off-site.

We will continue our efforts to achieve sustainable operations throughout the entire supply chain of procurement, manufacturing, logistics, and store operations of Skylark Group.

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
